

NetGalley for Librarians

Members of the American Library Association can utilize NetGalley **for free** to access digital review copies and audiobooks, and discover new authors and publishers!

As a librarian or library worker, you can:

Browse the [Catalog](#) to find books and audiobooks that are available to Request and Read Now.

Can't find a specific book? Keep in mind that not all books on NetGalley are visible in Find Titles – there are many books that publishers keep private (invite-only), so always feel free to ask your contact at the publisher if you can't find one of their books.

Be invited to download books: Let publishers know that you use NetGalley and are happy to receive invites to download digital review copies or audiobooks. A “widget” invite (special link) will give you *instant access* to the book, so you can download to your device quickly. [Learn more about using invites.](#)

Receive newsletters about upcoming books: On behalf of publishers, NetGalley sends email promotions for books that may interest you, so be sure your **Categories** are updated in your Profile and that you're [opted into our newsletters](#).

Submit Feedback to publishers: Let publishers know what you thought of the book & if you plan on purchasing it for your library. You can also nominate books for LibraryReads! [Read more here.](#)

To get started, [register](#) for your **free** account as a Librarian.

- **Make sure to [fill out your Profile](#)**, and include all essential information about your library and how you utilize digital review copies.
- **Add your ALA member ID number to your NetGalley profile.** When you request books on NetGalley, publishers will see the ALA logo near your name, allowing them to easily identify you as a confirmed ALA member. Librarians who enter their ALA numbers are generally approved more quickly and often (including being auto-approved).

To read NetGalley books on your device:

- **You can read NetGalley digital review copies and listen to audiobooks in the [NetGalley Shelf app](#)**, available for free on both iOS and Android devices. This app makes it easy for NetGalley members to instantly start reading or listening to books they've been approved to access.
- Or use our [Device Guide](#) to learn how to access your books on other devices or apps.
